

Administrative Resolution No. (278) of 2015
Concerning the
Registration of National Advocates
Working for Firms Licensed outside the Emirate¹

The Director General of the Government of Dubai Legal Affairs Department,

After perusal of:

- Law No. (32) of 2008 Establishing the Government of Dubai Legal Affairs Department,
- Executive Council Resolution No. (22) of 2011 Concerning Fees and Fines Prescribed for the Advocacy and the Legal Consultancy Profession in the Emirate of Dubai, and
- Administrative Resolution No. (233) of 2015 Adopting the Bylaw Concerning the Registration of Advocates in the Emirate of Dubai,

Does hereby issue the following Resolution:

Article (1)

National advocates who are registered in the Roll of Practising Advocates maintained by the Ministry of Justice, and who are working for advocacy firms licensed in the UAE, authorised to register and renew their registration with the Roll of Advocates maintained by the Department and practise the legal profession in the Emirate, in accordance with rules in force.

Article (2)

This Resolution shall come into force on 1 November 2015.
