	registration on the Roll in the category of practising Advocates, or reject to issue		
	a permit for a temporary pleading.		
	An applicant may not hold himself out as or represent that he is authorised to		
	practise the Profession in the Emirate beyond the scope of the authorisation		
	granted to him. Contravention of such shall result in the revocation of the		
	authorisation, without prejudice to the penalties prescribed in this regard.
