Requirements and Procedures			
Service requirements	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- Based on a request submitted by an advocate who was struck off for any of the violations stipulated by paragraph (A) of Article (20) of the Advocates Registration Bylaws, the Department may re-register the advocate after one year from the date of being struck off. 2- Based on a request submitted by an advocate who was struck off due to a judgment or a disciplinary action issued against him/her, the Department may re-register the advocate after three (3) years from the date of the write off. 3- The Department shall issue a resolution for re-registration of the advocate on the Roll of Practising Advocates should it find that the striking off period was sufficient for rehabilitation and for removing the impact of his/her violation. 4- Registration requirements stipulated by Article (7) of the advocates registration bylaws in the Emirate of Dubai must be observed for the re-registration of an advocate. Non-UAE National advocates who are registered at the Department shall be exempt from the clause of the aforementioned Article whenever it applies. 		

	<p>5- The applicant must pay the prescribed service fees as per the procedure approved by the Department in this regard.</p> <p>6- The applicant must be employed full time by the advocacy firm without practising any other commercial or professional activity in addition to his/her work except for teaching and training in a specific law area or legal practice.</p> <p>7- Any other requirements set by the Department pursuant to the bylaws, resolutions and instructions issued in this regard.</p>
Required documents	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Submit an application request and attach the required papers and documents. 2. Valid Emirates ID. 3. Valid passport. 4. Certificate of Good Conduct. 5. A letter issued by the proprietor of the firm where he/she will practise the profession that the proprietor approves to register the applicant as an advocate in the firm.
Steps/procedures for the service provision	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1- Submit the application request form and attach the required papers and documents 2- Remit the payment of the fees. 3- Receive the new registration card and a copy of the resolution of the re-registration of the advocate on the Roll of Practising Advocates.
