Requirements and Procedures			
<b>Service requirements</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The advocate should be registered on the Roll of Practising Advocates.</li> <li>2. Five (5) years of actual advocacy profession practice within the UAE.</li> <li>3. The applicant must be employed full time by the advocacy firm without practising any other commercial or professional activity in addition to his/her work except for teaching and training in a specific law area or legal practice.</li> <li>4. The applicant must comply with the registration requirements stipulated by Article (7) of the advocates registration bylaws in the Emirate of Dubai. Non-UAE National advocates who are registered at the Department shall be exempte from the clause of the aforementioned Article whenever it applies.</li> <li>5. The applicant must pay the prescribed service fees as per the procedure approved by the Department in this regard.</li> <li>6. Any other requirements set by the Department pursuant to the bylaws, resolutions and instructions issued in this regard.</li> </ol>		
<b>Required documents</b>	Copy of Advocate Ministry of Justice card stating his rights of audience before the High Court, or;		

	<p>A letter issued by Ministry of Justice that the advocate has completed 5 years of practising the advocacy profession in the UAE unless he/she has completed this period while being registered with the Government of Dubai Legal Affairs Department.</p>
<b>Procedures/steps for service provision</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Submit the application request form and attach the required papers and documents</li><li>2. Pay the fees.</li><li>3. Hand over the registration card to be amended</li><li>4. Receive the new registration card</li></ol>
